Graduation Severe Weather Plan:

If severe weather is forecasted on Graduation day, you will receive an email communication by 7:30 a.m. on Saturday, June 6th. This communication will call to delay the graduation ceremony or relocate to the CRMS Barn. We will make every effort to hold the ceremony outside, so plan accordingly if inclement weather is in the forecast, with the potential that we will be outside. If we must move the ceremony into the Barn, seating will be limited. We will give each graduate four tickets. All other guests on campus will be invited to watch a live stream of the ceremony from Jossman 9 or the Bar Fork.
