

2026 Summer Assignment

AP Spanish Language and Culture / Spanish Seminar - Advanced Study

There are two parts to the summer assignment.

Part 1 is the Cultural Presentation, is required.

Part 2 is the Elective option: choose one from the elective options below.

1. REQUIRED - Cultural Presentation:

Choose a community in a Spanish-speaking country and work on a presentation following the instructions in this document: [Presentacion Cultural AP Summer Work](#). You will present during the first week of classes. This presentation will be graded.

Important: You will need to share the presentation with me when you begin, and I will monitor progress every 15 days or so. You will need to start work by June 30. Please include notes on the slide next to the picture you are referring to. Part of the grade is slow learning and constant work (not all at the end). I will share a personal Google document with you, in which you will add your presentation link and a link to the work required below.

2. ELECTIVE Options - Choose One:

- **Grammar:** Review the conjugations for the following tenses (follow the links for practice). You need to complete at least 8 of the quizzes (4 for each tense) in order to fulfill this option.
 - [Present](#) (I eat fruit every day)
 - [Preterite](#) (I ate fruit yesterday)

NOTE: You have Conjuguemos links to all the verbs in each link. You can play games, do different activities. Have fun and learn! You also have personal quizzes here. You may not take the quizzes without doing Conjuguemos work first, until you earn 90% or above for your chosen verb type (you must do it within the time limit set – usually 10 mins). *It is about the road, not the finish.* Please copy and paste a screenshot of your work on Conjuguemos, and label each screenshot.

- **[La Mariposa School](#):** You can sign up for conversation classes here with a native speaker. Classes are \$12 for an hour. You need to complete 10 classes to fulfill this option. Write a short paragraph on our shared Google document after every class. Let me know what you

talked about, and maybe a word or two you learned.

- **NETFLIX Series:** Choose a Netflix show (original in Spanish, of course) to watch (in Spanish!). Put on Spanish subtitles and enjoy. Tell me what show you watched on our shared Google document, and write a paragraph about each episode. At least 10 hours.
- **Radio Ambulante:** Listen to at least 5 episodes (about 5 hours) during the summer. Write a short paragraph in Spanish for each podcast, on our shared Google document telling me what the podcast you listened to is about.
- **Duolingo:** You must show me your streak, and it should be 30 days or more, starting after school ends.

Our Shared Google Document:

This is a document I will share with you, where you will show me your summer work. You can always find this doc in 'Shared With Me' in your Google Drive. You can also save it to a folder in your email account and always find it there.

In the document, you need to:

- Place a link to your cultural presentations: Spring and Summer. I will check it periodically to see if you are working on it steadily. I want to see your Spring work to compare and make sure you are progressing.
- Note in the document your second choice (blue highlight), and share your work here. At times, it asks you to write a paragraph. At times, it is filling out the verb chart. Whatever your second choice is, it must be in our shared Google document.
- If you do Extra Credit, please also add this work to the Google document.

***EXTRA CREDIT** (a few more points on your first test—depending on how much you do). If you really want to get ahead and feel the required work is good, but you want to do more, you can do ½ of another elective option you did not choose for your main summer work.

Examples of what you can choose:

1. You can do 4 quizzes on the Grammar option (with the Conjuguemos practice) - 2 of each tense.
2. You could choose Netflix and do 5 hrs instead of 10.
3. You could choose the Mariposa School and do 5 hrs instead of 10.
4. You could choose 2 episodes of Radio Ambulante.
5. OR, you could choose Duolingo for 20 days (a little more than half the required).
